Scholarship Committee Composition

Recipients of the Joseph B. Mulenga Memorial Teaching Scholarship are selected and monitored by the Self Empowerment through Education (SEED) Scholarship Committee. Its members are a diverse group of individuals from the local community and its composition must heed the following guidelines:

The criteria for selection of committee membership are:

- the committee must be composed of at minimum 4 members, and at maximum 7 members
- the committee must contain at least one member from each of the following categories:
 - a current member of the SEED Board of Trustees (committee chairperson)
 - at least one teacher from the community
 - at least one professional from community
 - at least one community representative (non-professional)
- 'other' members may include:
 - a current US Peace Corps volunteer working in the district
 - a representative from the District Education Board Secretary (DEBS) office
 - a representative from the district teacher training college
 - any community member who may add productive discussion and perspective to the committee

Committee membership replacements:

- candidates will be identified by sitting committee members
- selections will be made by a formal majority vote of the sitting committee members
- tied votes will be determined by the selection committee chairperson
- new member selections must be approved by a majority vote of the SEED Executive Committee
